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## Section 708A Notice

**Emerald Resources NL (ASX: EMR)** ("Emerald") advises that it has issued 735,775,000 fully paid ordinary shares ("Shares") representing Tranche 1 of the placement to raise A\$75 million as announced on 24 January 2020 ("Placement").

Settlement of Tranche 1 Shares was completed on 3 February 2020 with 457,267,879 Shares issued pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 7.1 and 278,507,121 Shares pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 7.1A. The minor difference in the number of Shares settled in Tranche 1 as announced on 24 January 2020 is due to a reallocation of 26.3 million Shares to Tranche 2. Settlement of 1,139,225,000 Tranche 2 Shares is expected to occur on or about 18 March 2020, subject to shareholder approval.

The Company also advises that 17,500,000 unlisted \$0.025 options expiring 21 January 2020 issued under the Company's Incentive Plan were exercised prior to their expiry and as such 17,500,000 new Shares have been issued to the holders of these options.

As required under section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) ("Corporations Act") Emerald gives notice that;

- (a) The Company has issued:
  - 735,775,000 Shares at a fixed price of \$0.04 per Share, representing a 9.1% discount to the closing price of \$0.044 per share on 20 January 2020, a 8.7% discount to the 5 day VWAP of \$0.0438 per share and an 6.2% discount to the 10 day VWAP of \$0.0428 per share up to 20 January 2020; and
  - 17,500,000 Shares at \$0.025 per Share following exercise of options.
- (b) The Shares rank pari passu with existing Emerald shares.
- (c) The Shares were issued without disclosure to investors under Part 6D.2 of the Corporations Act.
- (d) As at the date of this notice, the Company has complied with:
  - the provisions of Chapter 2M of the Corporations Act, as they apply to the Company; and
  - Section 674 of the Corporation Act.
- (e) As at the date of this notice, there is no 'excluded information' (within the meaning of sections 708A(7) and 708A(8) of the Corporations Act) required to be disclosed under section 708A(6)(e) of the Corporations Act.

As announced on 24 January 2020, funds raised under the Placement will allow for the continuation of development activities whilst the Company finalises the Sprott US\$60 million Okvau Project finance facility (refer ASX announcement 26 June 2019) ("Facility") which is expected to combine the strong development credentials of the Emerald team with the financial strength of the respected Sprott group and results in the Company being fully funded for the development of the Okvau Gold Project.

In addition and as a further measure of support should it be required, Sprott has agreed to subscribe for up to US\$5 million in Emerald shares at the same issue price as the Placement as a contingency to protect against any adverse currency movements in relation to the minimum equity requirement under their proposed Facility. The Company will actively monitor currency and commodity price movements and implement strategies where considered appropriate to protect shareholder value. The subscription would be subject to successful completion and closure of the Facility and shareholder approval at the upcoming general meeting.

The Company is advancing development activities at the Okvau Gold Project including progressing contracts for essential capital equipment, supply of earthmoving equipment and mining services in line with previously announced intentions.

An Appendix 2A reflecting the revised capital structure following the allotment of the above securities has been released with this announcement.

## Cambodian Gold Project

### Summary

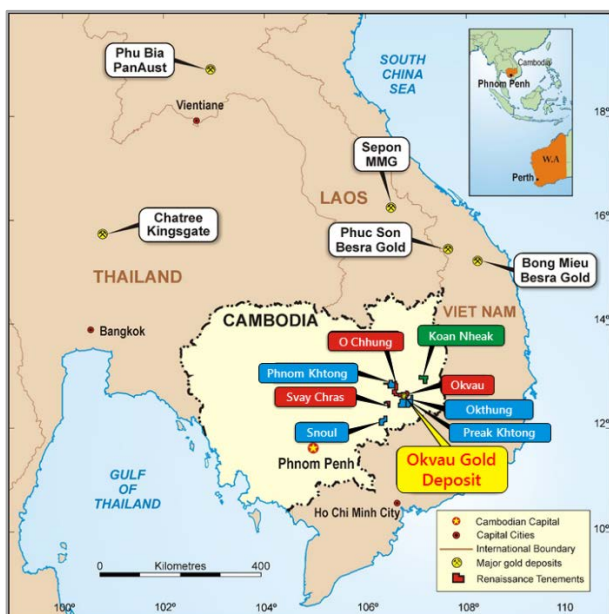
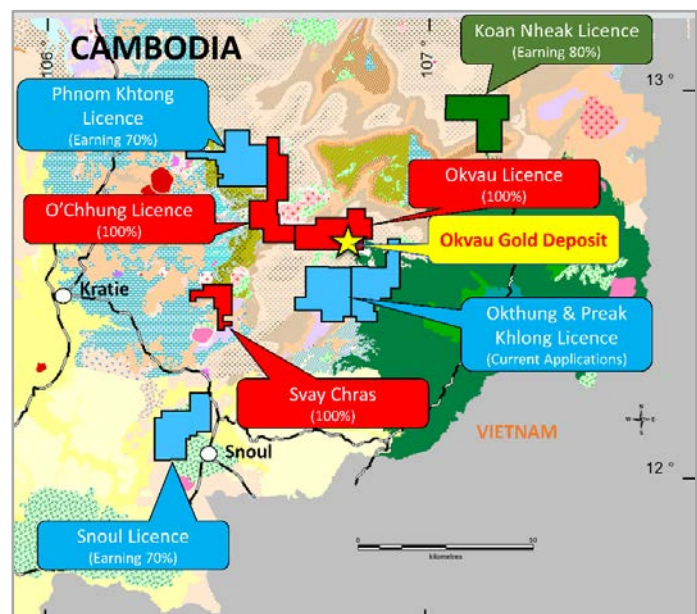


Figure 2 | Cambodian Gold Project | Exploration Licence Areas

Emerald's main focus is the exploration and development of its Cambodian Gold Projects which comprise of a combination of 100% owned granted licences, applications and earn-in & joint venture agreements covering a combined area of 1,442 km<sup>2</sup>. The 100% owned Okvau Gold Project ('Okvau Gold Project') is the Company's most advanced project which is located approximately 275 kilometres north-east of Cambodia's capital city of Phnom Penh in the province of Monduliri (refer Figures 1 and 2). The town of Kratie is located on the Mekong River approximately 90 kilometres to the west and the capital of Monduliri, Saen Monourom is located approximately 60 kilometres to the south-east. In May 2017, Emerald completed a Definitive Feasibility Study ('DFS') on the development of the Okvau Gold Project which demonstrated a robust project producing approximately 106,000 ounces of gold per annum on average over 7 years from a single open pit.

In July 2018, the Company was granted the Industrial Mining Licence covering 11.5 km<sup>2</sup> which allows for the development of the Okvau Gold Project. The Mining Licence has an initial 15-year period with the right to two renewals of up to 10-years for each renewal in accordance with Cambodian laws. The grant of the Mining Licence followed approval of the Okvau Gold Project by the Office of Council Ministers for both the rezoning of the project area to 'Sustainable Use' within the Phnom Prich Wildlife Sanctuary ('PPWS') and the granting of the Mining Licence. The rezoning of the Mining Licence area to 'Sustainable Use' lawfully permits commercial development under Cambodian law and follows the successful negotiation and approval by the Minister of Environment ('MoE') of the environmental contract (the 'Environmental Contract') and environmental licence ('Environmental Licence') in December 2017.

The Company has successfully completed the resettlement of 62 local families and site works to remove abandoned structures away from the Okvau Mining Licence area. Emerald has completed the installation of a security fence around the Project Development Area ("PDA") to ensure the safety of personnel, visitors and wildlife. Construction of a 35 tonne bridge across the Prek Te River has now been completed with substantial completion of upgrades to the existing 50km of dirt roads and current finalisation of the construction of 14km of new road to site which will allow for all year continuous access to the Okvau site.

Topography of the tenure area is relatively flat with low relief of 80 metres to 200 metres above sea level. The Okvau Deposit and other gold occurrences within the tenure are directly associated with diorite and granodiorite intrusions and are best classed as Intrusive Related Gold mineralisation. Exploration to date has demonstrated the potential for large scale gold deposits with the geology and geochemistry analogous to other world class Intrusive Related Gold districts, in particular the Tintina Gold Belt in Alaska (Donlin Creek 38Moz, Pogo 6Moz, Fort Knox 10Moz, Livengood 20Moz).

In December 2019 the Mineral Investment Agreement ('MIA') was signed which provides certainty and stability of the fiscal regime for the development and operations of the Okvau Gold Project. Following confirmation of the key fiscal incentives of the MIA, the key assumptions and inputs of the DFS were reviewed resulting in a significant improvement in the NPV and IRR of the Project.

Figure 1 | Cambodian Gold Project | Location
